Member privileges are extended to the member, spouse, domestic partner or significant other and member's children under 23 years of age.

- Prospective Member applications must be accompanied by a deposit equal to 1/3 the applicable initiation fee.
- There is an annual food and beverage minimum of \$700.00 for all Members.
- Initiation, dues, and assessments subject to applicable sales tax.
- Membership subject to approval by the Board of Directors.
- A potential end of year assessment for budgetary shortfalls. (historically \$350.00-\$400.00)
- All membership privileges and fees are governed by the Club's Board of Directors.
