Mid-Week Golf	Entitled to all the social and dining privileges of the Club. Use of the golf course, driving range and tennis courts for this Class shall be restricted to Monday after 1pm until 2pm Friday.	\$3,500	\$6,025
Intermediate Tennis	Entitled to all the privileges of a Regular Tennis Member.	\$1,750	\$2,510

Member privileges are extended to the member, spouse, domestic partner or significant other and member's children under 23 years of age.

- Prospective Member applications must be accompanied by a deposit equal to 1/2 the applicable initiation fee.
- There is an annual food and beverage minimum of \$750.00 for all Members.
- Initiation, dues, and assessments subject to applicable sales tax.
- Membership subject to approval by the Board of Directors.
- A potential end of year assessment for budgetary shortfalls. (historically approx. \$400)
- All membership privileges and fees are governed by the Club's Board of Directors.
